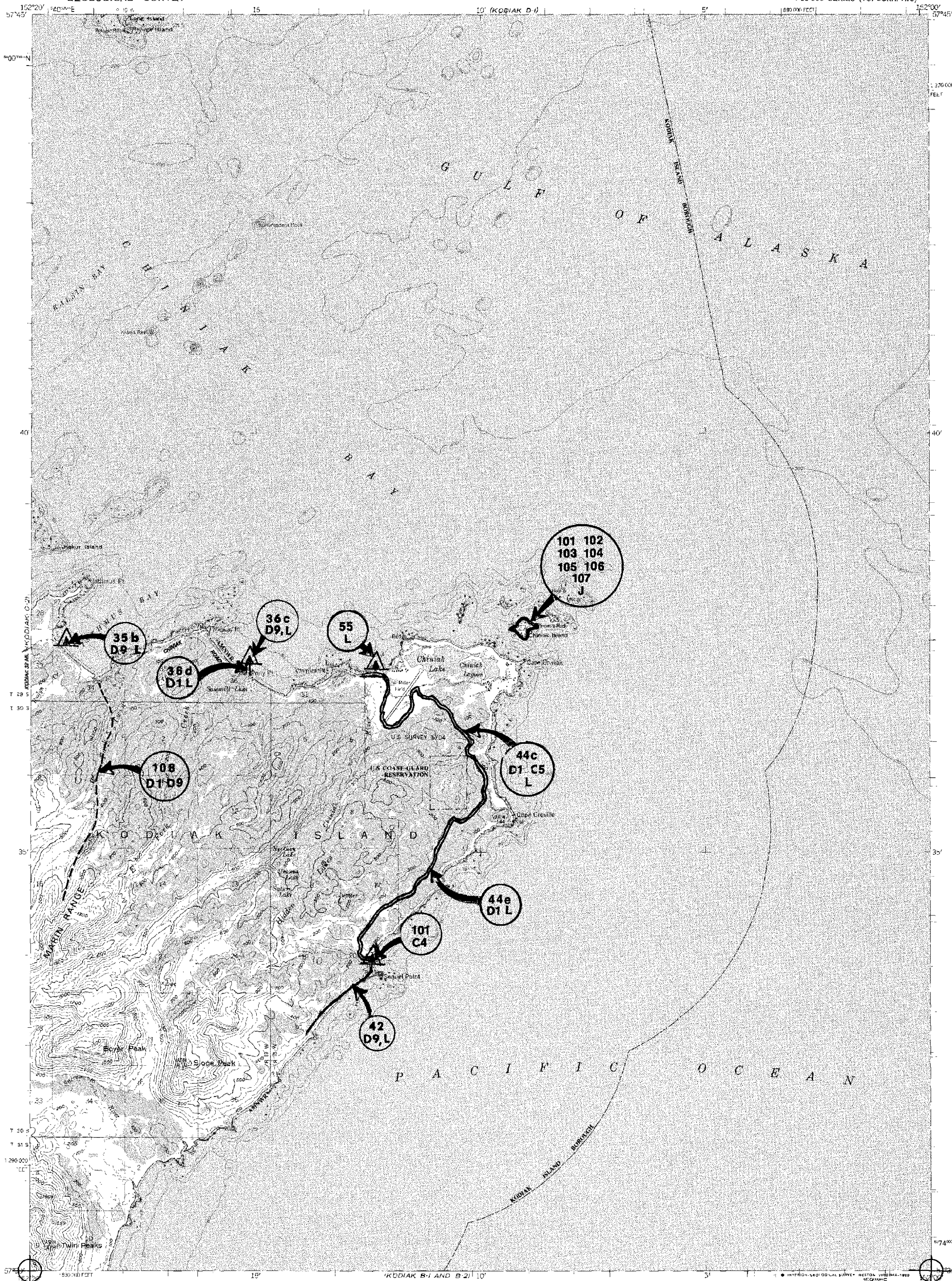

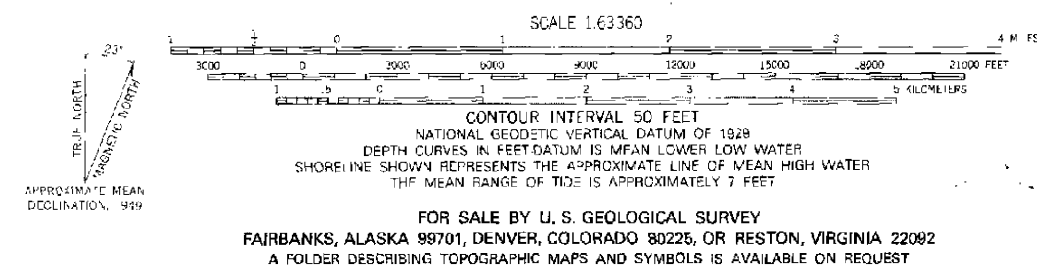
KODIAK (C-1) QUADRANGLE

Gray land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations
predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management
Folio S-23, Seward Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
